KINDER ORIENTATION

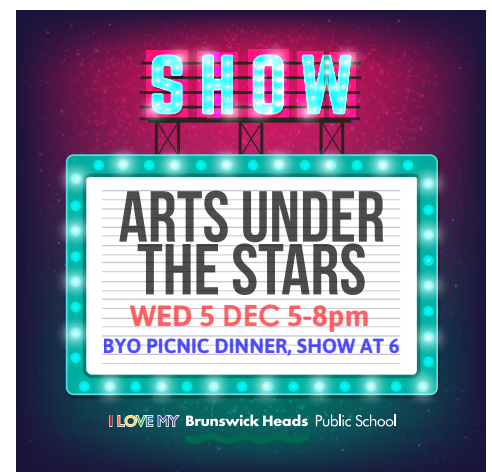

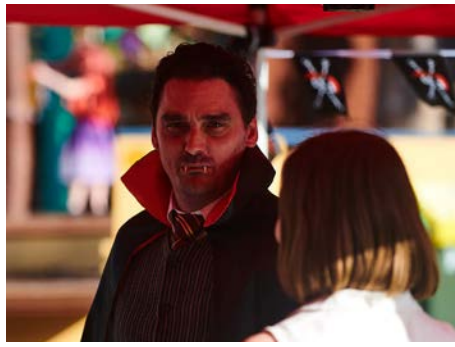
